

'BOOK SWAP' - A NEW INITIATIVE OF MSSW LIBRARY

In an attempt to supplement the collection for general reading and to promote community reading, the 'Book Swap' initiative provides an option of sharing / circulating / swapping one's used books (novels and fictions – English or any language) among other interested readers by placing them in a centralised place i.e., the exclusive rack kept at the entrance of the Library.

Guidelines to be followed for successful 'Book Swap'

- All faculty members and students are welcome to donate used (in a reasonably good condition) / new novels and fictions for the "Book Swap" scheme. They are free to indicate their name as the donor on the first page of the book.
- As the objective of the 'Book Swap' initiative is only to supplement the collection for general reading, the donors should make available only such genre of books. Donors are informed to take utmost care in avoiding controversial books or books with vulgar content or pirated versions for 'Book Swap'. The College will not be held responsible for such anomalies.
- Books once donated for the 'Book Swap' scheme will remain the property of the 'Book Swap' scheme. The donors cannot claim the donated books on a later date.
- The books available for 'Book Swap' belong to all interested readers. Hence utmost care and caution need to be exercised while handling the books.
- The books available for 'Book Swap' are meant to be swapped. Hence all users should responsibly replace the books within a reasonable time, say 15 days after taking it for reading. Otherwise, swapping will not happen.
- It is suggested that each reader takes only one book at a time for reading.
- MSSW Library is only a facilitator of the 'Book Swap' scheme. The Books available for this initiative are not the books of MSSW Library. The 'Book Swap' users will not receive overdue reminders or will not have to pay fines. Success of the scheme depends solely on the users. Let us make it a success!!
